

PTO Board Meeting Minutes - October 20, 2020

Call to Order: 5:30pm

PTO Reports:

- Last meeting minutes were read and reviewed.
- Treasurer reported that \$11,674.62 is our balance.
 - We need to deposit a check from King Soopers for \$576.99.
 - 24 families have a Shopper's Card signed up for the Kroger Community Rewards program. We are going to advertise to see if more Red Feather Families will join.
 - The amount we are receiving from Kroger Community Rewards is enough to cover our operating costs, so fundraisers can fund student enrichment.

Principals Report:

- Mountain Schools are working hard to adjust to new safety protocols to keep COVID out and our schools open. Ultimately we are working towards having the students in the school 5 days a week.
- Cold and Flu season is coming, please keep kids home if they are sick.
- The Fox Acres Golf Tournament was cancelled until next year. They will begin planning for the event after the new year.
 - Most participants and sponsors declined a refund, so the cancelled event raised \$18,000 for Red Feather Lakes student experiences and school supplies.
- School kitchens will hopefully be licensed in November and then school lunches will be prepared on site.

New Business

- Student Activities/Purchases Proposed
 - Water coolers for each classroom to support Phase 3 was discussed and approved by a unanimous vote. We will look into joining Livermore Elementary on their bulk water order. Kat offered to bring the water deliveries up to the school from Livermore.
 - Kat and Elaine discussed their plans for an in class Halloween party. They have asked the PTO to make goody bags for each student. The request

was unanimously approved and supplies were ordered directly following the meeting.

- Roberts Ranch, of Livermore, is offering to let local families come hike and explore the archeological treasures of their ranch. The details of these hiking opportunities will be sent out as they become available.
- Volunteer Needs
 - Orvilles, in partnership with Deli Dan's and the Trading Post, is putting on a Thanksgiving meal to raise money for Livermore and Red Feather PTOs. We will be reaching out to see if they would like any help from the PTO such as provide student artwork for decorations.
